

SHOWCASING NATURE THROUGH GOLF IN THE BEAUTIFUL OZARK MOUNTAINS

Big Cedar Golf Fact Sheet

Big Cedar Lodge has quickly become one of the premier golf destinations in the United States and was recognized in 2025 by USA Today 10Best as the Best Golf Resort in the United States. In fall 2020, the first public access course by Tiger Woods' TGR Design, Payne's Valley, opened and joined the four existing and top-rated courses at the resort – Ozarks National (Bill Coore & Ben Crenshaw), Buffalo Ridge (Tom Fazio), Mountain Top (Gary Player) and Top of the Rock (Jack Nicklaus). These world-class courses bring Johnny Morris' vision to life by creating an unparalleled golf experience in the Missouri Ozarks, attracting visitors from across the world.

Payne's Valley

Designed by: Tiger Woods' TGR Design
Course Opening: September 22, 2020

Named in honor of golf legend and Ozarks native, the late Payne Stewart, the new "Payne's Valley" course was the first completed fully public-access course in the world designed by Tiger Woods' design firm, TGR Design. The 18-hole layout showcases the region's natural beauty and features an extraordinarily dramatic 19th hole, "The Big Rock at Payne's Valley," designed by Bass Pro Founder Johnny Morris. The spectacular finishing hole is a par 3 that can be used to settle unfinished bets, and is set against a 200 foot limestone cliff and roaring waterfall. With multiple tee boxes, the course is challenging for the world's best players yet player-friendly with wide fairways and an unforgettable finish. The course officially opened in fall 2020 with a grand opening event, The Payne's Valley Cup, where American greats Tiger Woods and Justin Thomas challenged European standouts Rory McIlroy and Justin Rose. It was named the #3 Best Public Golf Course by USA Today 10Best in 2025 along with the #3 Top Public-Access Golf Course in Missouri by Golfweek.

Ozarks National

Designed by: Bill Coore & Ben Crenshaw Course Opening: April 29, 2019

The world-renowned golf course architect team of Coore & Crenshaw shares Johnny Morris' passion and appreciation for nature and conservation. Honored as the Best New Public Course of 2019 by Golf Digest and the Top Public-Access Course in Missouri in 2025 by Golfweek, the design of Ozarks National is a striking display for the senses and a fitting tribute to the Ozarks region. It tests avid players and golf travelers from around the country. With breathtaking views, the course also includes interesting features, such as a 400-foot wooden beam and plank bridge, which connects the tee box and fairway of the 13th hole that stands 60-feet above a flowing creek.

Mountain Top

Designed by: Gary Player Course Opening: August 31, 2017

The 13-hole Mountain Top Course designed by Gary Player was created to bring a more accessible experience to golfers of all skill levels. Acknowledged by GOLF.com as one of the Best Par-3 Courses in America, Mountain Top routes through unforgettable rock formations. Player teamed up with Johnny Morris to create an unparalleled experience for golfers that features some of the most breathtaking and unobstructed views in the region. Mountain Top also offers a Himalayan-style putting course designed by 5-time Open Champion Tom Watson.

Buffalo Ridge Designed by: Tom Fazio

Course Reopening Following Renovation: June 2014, June 2025

Buffalo Ridge is an 18-hole championship public golf course ranked by *GOLF Magazine* as the No. 2 Public Golf Course in Missouri, 2025. Following Big Cedar Lodge's acquisition of the course in 2013, renowned course architect Tom Fazio and visionary conservationist Johnny Morris worked side-by-side to complete a major course renovation project. The new layout brings players in close contact with nature and features pristine playing conditions.

Herds of roaming bison graze on the native prairie grasses that surround the golf course boundaries. The renovation unveiled natural rock formations that have been incorporated into the routing of the course. Other improvements include the beautification and enhancement of all water features, the creation of new water features, and completely rebuilt bunkers with new white sand. Buffalo Ridge covers approximately 450 acres and the course measures 7,036 yards from the back tees.

Top of the Rock

Designed by: Jack Nicklaus Course Opening: MONTH, 1996

Course Reopening Following Renovation: June 2014

Top of the Rock is a true celebration of nature and Ozarks heritage, sitting at the highest elevation in Taney County, Missouri, overlooking the Ozark Mountains and Table Rock Lake. GOLF.com acknowledged Top of the Rock as one of the Best Par-3 Courses in America. Honored as the first par-3 course to be featured on a PGA TOUR-sanctioned event, the 9-hole course offers an unrivaled golf experience with unparalleled panoramic views that highlight the work of the course architect, Jack Nicklaus. After their round, golfers are treated to a nature experience like no other on the Lost Canyon Cave and Nature Trail at Top of the Rock, a two-mile self-guided journey by golf cart through the Ozarks landscape.

In addition to world-class golf, Top of the Rock is a multi-faceted destination featuring: Lost Canyon Cave and Nature Trail; Top of the Rock Golf Course, and Pro Shop; Ancient Ozarks Natural History Museum; Arnie's Barn Restaurant & General Store; Osage Restaurant; Buffalo Bar; End of the Trail All-American Wine Cellar; the Chapel of the Ozarks; the Civil War-era Jack's Cabin; and the Cathedral of Nature, which originally revealed itself in 2015 when the site opened up due to a sinkhole. Since then, 82,500 dump truck loads of dirt have been removed unveiling one of the greatest wonders of the Ozarks.

Cliffhangers

Designed by: Johnny and JP Morris Course Opening: July 4, 2025

The most extraordinary par-3 course on Earth! Created by Bass Pro Shops founder Johnny Morris and his son John Paul, Cliffhangers dangles on a steep hillside adjacent to Payne's Valley with 18 holes ranging from 60 to 170 yards. The adventure course features dramatic elevation changes, breathtaking views, and holes meticulously carved into the region's iconic limestone cliffs and flowing creeks.

Accommodations Angler's

Angler's Lodge Hollister and Payne's Valley Cottages

The newly opened Angler's Lodge Hollister and Payne's Valley Cottages offer travelers the perfect accommodations for a golf focused trip to the Ozarks. At Angler's Lodge Hollister, guests enjoy being a short drive away from some of the top golf courses in the country with access to Big Cedar attractions like Fun

Mountain, Dogwood Canyon, Cedar Creek Spa and more.

Angler's Lodge offers 94 custom rooms that combine rustic touches with modern finishes. These accommodations offer simple, functional spaces that put couples, families, and groups in a central location to take advantage of all the activities and amenities in the Ozarks. Amenities include complimentary breakfast, a shuttle to Big Cedar golf courses, daily housekeeping, a fitness room, and more.

The Payne's Valley Cottages are located on the ridge below the Mountain Top clubhouse and provide sweeping views of the Ozark mountains overlooking Payne's Valley and Mountain Top. These new cottages feature stone fireplaces, private patios, a full kitchen, and more. They are perfectly suited for a golf buddy's trip or for the family looking for a pristine setting close to world-class golf yet a short 15-minute drive away from the award-winning amenities included on Big Cedar's main campus.
